New Business:

The Booster Club has received letters from the students and Varsity coaches indicating their requests. The Booster Club was in favor of allowing each student a total of \$250.00 payable as their last payment which is sometime in February.
- Basketball Shoot A Thon
- Varsity Basketball turned in \$732.35 to Booster Club
- Varsity Basketball Half-time contests for Booster Club to do:
 - Do 50/50 raffles
 - Shoot A Thon during the half-time again for food or merchandiseEric Yapple will MC the halftime contest. We can sell tickets at the door for anyone interested. Booster Club will make an outline for this and try it at the next home game if possible (Dec. 21.). If this date is not possible we will try it in January. Eric will get back to Sandy and Linda.
- New Merchandise: The style of green fleece we used to sell (1/4 zip) needs to be ordered 36 at a time. We can get full zip green fleeces from our reg. supplier a few at a time – they are a bluer green than the others. Stadium Blankets with a strap around them. These blankets, Booster Club could sell for \$13.00 each. The motion was made to order 6 full zip fleece and

- 24 or more stadium blankets. We have 21 T-Shirts in stock, the idea was to maybe have a basketball put on the front, and net on the back, Booster Club could sell these for \$10.00.
